

Out of State/Unemployment Process

- Please contact your previous state to determine which state to file. There are so many different scenarios, we cannot advise. Contact them the week of March 23rd, or it may be considered untimely, and not be able to receive SUB PAY (THIS APPLIES TO ALL STATES)
- If you were laid off last year, and your benefit year has not ended with your previous state monetary determination, you must file your claim with that state. When your benefit year ends, you must file (or open) with State of Tennessee immediately to file your claim.
- When you open your new unemployment claim in your previous state, your Out-of-State Monetary Determination will have to be faxed to SUB to Attention: Lynnore Foote (248) 365-9809 so it can be processed manually.
